

- (xxv) Trust has right to take any type of work and make a tender in any Govt Officials/ & Pvt agency if for benefit of the trust.
- (xxvii) Trust can do any type of work relates to business/ Profession & other work if for benefit of the trust.
- (xxviii) To do any other act for the advancement of general public utility not involving on or any activities for benefit without distribution of caste, clour & creed.
- (xxix) To strive for making a society imbued with love & Justice in accordance with principles of Sarvodaya & Antoday Schemes.
- (xxx) To do all such things as may be deemed necessity by the Board of Trustee of the Trust from time to time in attainment of the objectives and programmes Schemes introduced by the govt. or private authority.

**POWER OF THE TRUSTEES:**

The founder trustees shall hold office for life and upon their death or disability they are entitled to nominate a person of their kin. The first board of trustees can not be removed or replaced and upon their death or disability the legal heir or nominator person in their family shall hold office in their place. The M.D is life time member at any situation and any type of decision will be taken in the Board and not approved without prior consent of M.D.

The trustees shall have the power and authority to administer the trust and its properties and to do all acts, deeds and things to promote the objects of the trust. The Trustee shall have power and authority for the purpose of this trust.

(a) Invest the funds of the trust in the modes prescribed under the provisions of the sections 13(1) (d) read with section 11(5) of the income tax act 1961.

- (b) To sell, mortgage, grant lease, hire or alienate the properties of the trust.
- (c) To borrow money with or without security and to repay the same.
- (d) Enter into contracts, vary and rescind them.
- (e) To open bank accounts and provide for operation thereon from time to time.
- (f) To receive gifts, grants, endowments and donation in cash or kind.
- (g) To institute, prosecute and defend all legal suits and other proceedings.
- (h) To appear and act before courts, tribunals, governmental tax and other public authorities.
- (i) To appoint, terminate dismiss, suspend and otherwise deal with the employees of the trust and its institutions.
- (j) To apply the properties and funds of the trust for all or any of the objects for which the trust is established as may be determined by the trustees from time to time.
- (k) To decide from time to time the activities & projects to be undertaken for fulfilling the objects of the trust.
- (l) To frame rules & bye laws for the management of the trust, and its properties & proceedings and to amend or rescind them from time to time subjects to clause (15) below.
- (m) To incur all necessary expenses connected with the trust.
- (n) The founder member and the chairman are authorized to execute any document with or without registration including amendments to the trust deed.

6. Power and duties of individual office bearers:

(i) Managing Director Cum Chairman :- The Managing Director shall have power :-

- (a) To call for the meeting of the board of trustees or the office bearers in special circumstances.
- (b) To have supervision and control over trust funds.
- (c) To exercise casting vote in case of a tie in any matter in the meetings of the board of trustees office bearers.

- (d) To make needful decision along with other office bearers in times of emergency for the promotion of the objects of the trust.
- (e) To mobilize funds for the trust.
- (f) In the absence of chairman vice chairman can act as a chairman and can do every possible work on behalf of chairman for benefit of the trust.
- (g) To call for and preside over all meetings of the board of trustees and of the office bearers of the trust.
- (h) To address letters to the dignitaries on important matters.
- (i) To mobilize funds for the trust.
- (j) The M.D. shall have superintending powers on all matters concerning the trust.
- (k) To veto the decision of the board of trustees if it is not in the interests of the trust.
- (l) To make rules and regulations for the conduct of the profession or business & other work of the trust as well as for the governance and conduct of the unit as established by them.
- (m) The M.D. along with trustees shall have the power to create such other legal unit and entitles as may be necessary in their opinion to effectively carry out the object of the trust.
- (n) To employ servants, agents and secure services of professional people like advocates, auditors etc. and to create a cadre and to appoint staff for the unit created by the trust along with rules of service conditions.
- (o) To provide financial and in such manner and in such conditions as the trustees might deem it proper for the objects and schemes of the unit consistent with the object or promoting the aim of the trust consistent with the object or promoting the aim of the trust.
- (p) To empower anyh trustees by the power of astorney to act for and represent the trustees and further sign legal papers and documents on behalf of the trustees.

(ii) Director Finance & Accounts :- The Director (Finance) shall have power as Treasurer, details given as below :

- (a) To operate the bank accounts of the trust jointly and one member/ Director of the board of trust.
- (b) To maintain cause to be maintained all books of accounts as per the directions of the board of trustees and/ or office bearers of the trust.
- (c) To prepare or cause to be prepared the statement of receipts and payments incurred for every month and place the same before the office bearers of the trust with the co-operation and assistance of the secretary.
- (d) To maintain or cause to be maintained all necessary books of accounts, vouchers and other connected in the office of the trust.
- (e) To submit or Noz to be submitted his accounts for internal audit and for annual audit and prepare or cause to be prepared the annual statement of accounts including receipts and payments, income and expenditure and balance sheet and place the same for the approval of the trustees of the trust and after approval circular the same among all the trustees.
- (f) The custodian of the trust funds with the prior consent of M.D.
- (g) To mobilize funds for the trust with the prior consent of M.D.

(iii) Director (Administration) :- *Director (Adm.) shall have power :*

- (a) To be the executive officer of the trust.
- (b) Accept all notices, summons and writs.
- (c) To sue or be sued for and on behalf of the trust unless otherwise decided.
- (d) To function as per the direction of the chairman and the board of trustees, in that order.

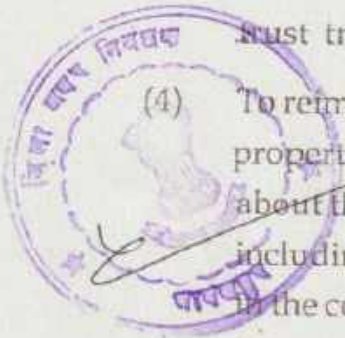

VI. Investment :

- (1) The trust funds shall be invested in the modes specified under the provisions of section 13 (1) (d) read with section 11 (5) of the income tax act 1961 as amended from time to time.
- (2) To apply and use the funds of the trust for all or any of the objects of the trust.
- (3) To receive any money or other assets in any shape or form as and when given by the author of the trust or any other person/s as gift or donation and to hold the same as part of the capital fund of the trust if such donor expresses his desire to so treat the same, or to make it available for the application to further the objects of the trust treating the same as income of the trust.
- (4) To reimburse themselves or pay and discharge out of funds or any property of the trust, all expenses that may be incurred in or about the execution of the trust and the costs of these presents including reasonable amount of travelling expenditure incurred in the course of the discharge of their duties including attending to any meeting of the board of trustees.



(5) To acquire on lease or purchase or otherwise and to sell, mortgage, hire, lease or transfer or in any other manner whatsoever, movable or immovable properties, to ~~construct hotels, school and/or other buildings and to carry out other improvements~~ there of for the purpose of the trust and to manage properties, movable and immovable, and all other assets of the trust and to mortgage them, to repay loans or otherwise to ~~deal generally with the assets for the purpose of the trust, to let out, lease, mortgage, charge or grant license to use any property belonging to the trust for such rent or compensation and on such terms and conditions as the board of trustees may think fit.~~ Its activities or its other affairs and for the management of the trust.

(9) To do all other acts, deeds, matters and things which may be deemed necessary for carrying out the objects of the trust or its administration.

V. Delegation:

The board of trustees may from time to time, delegate to one or more of their body, such of their ~~powers and duties as they deem fit~~ subject nevertheless to their retaining the ultimate control and

(6) To borrow, take loan from banks, financial institutions, borrow or raise any money that ~~may be required by the trust for the achievements of its object upon such terms as may be deemed advisable and in particular by the issue of promissory notes or by mortgage or charge on all or any part of the immovable or movable assets belonging to the trust.~~

(7) To open accounts of any nature in any Nationalise/Private bank/s and operate such account/s or authorize operations of the said accounts by the M.D. & Director (Finance) jointly.

(8) To pay out of the trust funds salaries, wages, rent building maintenance, repairs and other expenses relating to the trust and supervision.

VI.

Accounts :

The trustees shall duly maintain true and correct accounts of all assets, liabilities, receipts and expenses of the trust and a correct record of the meetings and deliberations. The year of account of the trust shall be the first of April to the 31st of March every year. It shall however be open to the trustees to change the year of account, if they find it more convenient to do so. The board of trustees shall get the accounts of the trust duly audited every year by a chartered accountant.

VII. Indemnity:

The trustees shall be kept indemnified against any action or proceeding, cost or claim, demand or liability for anything done by them in good faith, pursuant to the power and authority vested in them under this deed.

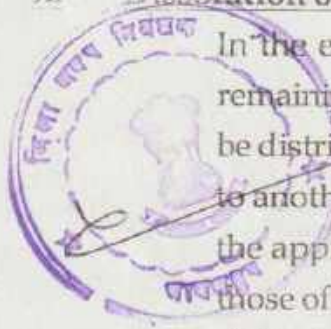
VIII. Amendments to the trust deed :

No amendments to this trust deed or any rules or regulations framed by the trustees, shall be made which may prove to be repugnant to the provisions of section 2(15), 11-13 and 80G of the income tax act 1961, subject to the above, the Trustees may amend the provisions of the trust deed, provided however no amendment shall be carried out without the prior approval of the commissioner of income tax.

IX Irrevocable : The trust formed shall be irrevocable.

X. Dissolution of the trust :

In the event of dissolution or winding up of the trust, the asset remaining as on the date of dissolution shall under no circumstances be distributed among the trustees but the same shall be transferred to another charitable trust, society association or institution with the approval of M.D Cum Chairman whose objects are similar to those of this trust and which enjoys recognitions under section 80G of the income Tax Act 1961.



XI. Utilization of the funds and income of the trust :

The Funds And income of the trust shall be utilized for the Achievement of the objects of the trust and no portion of it shall be utilized for payment to the trustees by way of profit, interest or dividend. The trustees who render fulltime professional or other services to the trust shall be paid a harmonium amount monthly.

XII. Benefit of the Trust :

The benefit of the trust shall be open to all public irrespective of Caste, Colour, Sex, Creed or religion.

XIII. Trust Property :

The trust property shall consist of the initial trust fund contributed by the founder members and any properties taken by the trust & if gifted by the other Trust/NGO or public or relates to public properties etc.

XIV. Board of Trustees :

The trust shall comprise of founder trustees, hereditary trustees and Co-opted trustees. The board of trustees shall Co-opt two eminent persons of the community who will be useful to the trust for mobilization of resources and contribute a sum of Rs. Total 21,000/- towards the corpus fund. Co-opted trustees shall be appointed for a period of one year which can be extended for two more consecutive years, which shall be decided by the chairman of the board of trustees. The Co-opted trustees shall have all powers and authority of a lifetime trustee. The management and control of the trust and trust properties shall rest in the chairman of the board of trustees. The boards of trustees shall comprise of not less than two and not more than eleven trustees including the founder, trustees, chairman, secretary, treasurer and managing trustee. The following shall be the first board of trustees with their name, address and designations.
